

## Superior Township Tax Assessment Roll of 1840

On the following pages is the Tax Assessment Roll of Superior Township for the year 1840. This assessment roll was probably prepared by Robert T. Wheelock, the Superior Township supervisor, the preparation of the tax roll being one of his duties at that time. This 1840 tax assessment roll contains a number of errors with respect to the spelling of township resident names. Also, on occasion, there is some difficulty in determining the spelling intended; a factor of both the writing implements employed at that time and the diligence of the writer. I have compared this 1840 tax roll with the tax roll of 1842 and have entered in parenthesis the name shown on the 1842 tax roll name below the 1840 tax roll name in those cases where a discrepancy exists. Also in parenthesis are other insertions that help to clarify the 1840 assessment roll. Parenthetical notations on the original documents are shown in brackets. A "p" following the tax amount in the right hand column denotes that the tax is indicated in the book as having been paid. There are notations on this tax assessment roll for which there is no evident explanation and are not included in this transcription. Commas are inserted on occasion for clarity.

On the following page is a cover letter that accompanied the 1840 Tax Assessment Roll.

This 1840 Tax Assessment Roll is the second entry in a bound volume of early tax assessment rolls currently maintained in the vault of the Superior Township Hall bearing the title Superior Twn 1835-1854. The tax appears to have been 7% of the adjudged value of the individual's real and personal estate.

To **Hammonde Gerow**, collector of the township of **Superior** in said county greeting:

You are hereby commanded to collect from the several persons named in the assessment roll hereto annexed, the several sums mentioned in the last column of such roll, opposite their respective names, and out of the monies so collected after deducting the compensation to which you may be lawfully entitled, you are further commanded to pay,

*First*, to the treasurer of the said township of **Superior** the sum of **One Hundred & Ninety dollars & sixty five cents** being the sum raised therein for the support of highways and bridges, and to defray other township expenses.

*Second*, to the treasurer of said county, the residue of said money so to be collected; and in case any person named in the said assessment roll, shall refuse or neglect to pay his tax, you are hereby authorized and required to levy the same by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of such person; and you are further required to make all the payments herein specified, on or before the first day of February next ensuing the date hereof.

Witness our hands, at Ann Arbor, in said county, this **fourteenth** day of **November** A.D. 1839
