

ORDER GRANTING ABEYANCE

On November 14, 2006, the Parties filed a Stipulated Joint Motion to Hold Case in Abeyance. The purpose of the Motion is to allow the Petitioner time to proceed with the rezoning process through Intervenor Charter Township of Superior. Based on the Stipulated Joint Motion, it is determined that holding the case in abeyance pending Petitioner's rezoning request is appropriate. While this case is being held in abeyance, the Petitioner shall file periodic status reports every 90 days with the Tribunal. Any other Party may also file periodic status reports regarding this case.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Parties Stipulated Joint Motion to Hold Case in Abeyance is GRANTED.
2. The Petitioner shall file status reports every 90 days beginning on February 14, 2007.
