Notice Is Hereby Given that on September 14, 2016, the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of District Boundaries and a Day of Review of Apportionments from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the Western County Service Center, 705 N. Zeeb Rd, 2nd floor, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48103.

The Water Resources Commissioner, engineers and other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review.

The **Day of Review of District Boundaries** is for the purpose of reviewing and revising the boundaries of the Drainage Districts below; and is an opportunity to review the Drainage District boundaries with the Water Resources Commissioner or a member of his staff. The **Day of Review of Apportionments** is an opportunity to review the apportionment with the Water Resources Commissioner or a member of his staff.

The assessment amount shown above is estimated only and subject to change based on findings at the Day of Review.




