The new 26,000 SF state-of-the-art shelter opened in the fall of 2009. The new facility provides a healthy, low-stress, family-friendly environment to house cats, dogs, and other animals that need homes.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn RIGHT (north) on Prospect Rd. (0.9 miles)
- Turn LEFT (west) on Ford Rd/M-153 (0.6 miles)
- Turn LEFT (west) on Ford Rd (1.6 miles)
- Turn LEFT (south) on Plymouth Rd (0.6 miles)
- Turn LEFT (south) on Cherry Hill Rd (0.4 miles)
