

Kosch-Headwaters Preserve

Prospect Road at Ford Road, Superior Township, MI 48198



The 160-acre Kosch-Headwaters Preserve is operated by the Washtenaw County Parks & Recreation Commission, and features a wonderful maple-beech woodland. Seasonal streams and a spring flowing out of the woodlands contribute to Fowler Creek, and ultimately to the Rouge River (hence the name “headwaters”). Currently, approximately 50% of the land is cultivated, but a short ¼-mile walk around the periphery of the planted field leads to walking trails in the woods.

Kosch-Headwaters Preserve abuts and shares a small lake with the Springhill Nature Preserve, owned by the Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Turn RIGHT (north) on Prospect Rd. (0.8 miles)

Turn RIGHT (east) into parking area

The preserve is on the RIGHT (east) side of Prospect Road. The entrance and small parking area are well marked by a yellow "Nature Preserve" sign.

Park Hours:

Daily, dawn to dusk
