**ORDINANCE NO. 104**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 86.**

THE TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR, COUNTY OF WASHTENAW, STATE OF MICHIGAN,  
ORDAINS:

SECTION I

ARTICLE III of Ordinance 86 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Whenever the Fire Department responds to a false alarm, the person or agency whose property is served by the alarm system shall pay a fee according to the following schedule:

1. No charge for the first false alarm each month.
2. Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for the second false alarm each month.
3. One hundred (\$100.00) dollars for the third and each subsequent alarm in a given month.

The above charges shall be paid to the Township Treasurer within 30 days. Failure to pay such charges shall subject the property to a lien against said property in such an amount, and such lien to be enforced in the manner prescribed by the General Laws of the state providing for the enforcement of tax liens.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper circulated within the Township of Superior within thirty (30) days following the final adoption thereof.

This Ordinance shall become effective September 30, 1989. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith the hereby repealed.
