

**SUPERIOR CHARTER TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 123

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT (ACT 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED).

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR ORDAINS:

Section 123-01. Agency Designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Building, Electrical, Mechanical and Plumbing Codes, in accordance with Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the code official of the Charter Township of Superior is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Charter Township of Superior under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Charter Township of Superior assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

Section 123-02. Repeal All Previous Inconsistent Ordinances

All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 123-03. Publication

This ordinance shall be published in the Ypsilanti Press, a newspaper having general circulation in said Township, and shall become effective upon January 31, 1994.
