

SUPERIOR CHARTER TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 68

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR, WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN,  
HEREBY ORDAINS:

**Section 68-01 – Title**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as: “The Superior Township  
Emergency Snow Ordinance”.

**Section 68-02 - Provisions**

Until snow removal has been completed it shall be unlawful to park or cause to be  
parked any motor vehicle, van, or trailer on any street in the residential district of the  
township, if snowfall rated yellow has been declared, and/or there has been a snowfall of  
two or more inches within the proceeding twenty four (24) hours.

Each day a violation occurs shall be deemed a separate offense.

**Section 68-03 – Penalties**

Violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor and upon conviction before a court of  
competent jurisdiction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 and costs of  
prosecution. Violators shall also be subject to such towing costs as established by the  
Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners pursuant to resolution of said Board from  
time to time.

**Section 68-04 – Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective 30 days from the date of final adoption.

A true copy of this ordinance shall be published in the Ann Arbor News and the  
Ypsilanti Press being the newspapers of general circulation in the Charter Township of  
Superior and shall take effect on February 17, 1980.
