ORDINANCE No. 93
REGULATION OF MINOR CHILDREN

WHEREAS, the Charter Township of Superior Board of Trustees having determined there exists a specific local problem related to the prevalent misbehavior of minors within the lawful limits of this Township, and it having been determined that it is the responsibility of parent(s) and/or legal guardians(s) to ensure that their minor children or ward(s) avoid such misbehavior in violation of the ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR,
WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

Section 93.01 - A minor under the age of thirteen (13) years shall not loiter, idle or congregate in or on any public street, highway, alley, or park within the Township of Superior between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or guardian, or an adult delegated by the parent or guardian to accompany the minor.

Section 93.02 - A minor under the age of seventeen (17) years shall not loiter, idle or congregate in or on any public street, highway, alley, or park within the Township of Superior between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 A.M. unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or guardian, or an adult delegated by the parent or guardian to accompany the minor, or where the minor is upon an errand or other legitimate business as directed by his parent or guardian.

Section 93.03 - It shall be unlawful for any person, parent, or guardian to allow or permit, or to assist, aid, abet, or encourage any minor under the age of seventeen (17) years to violate the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 hereof, to commit any criminal act, or to come or tend to come under the jurisdiction of the juvenile division of the probate court as defined in Act 288 of the Public Acts of 1939 as amended being MCLA 712A.2.

Section 93.04 - Any person found violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be sentenced to a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or 90 days in jail.

Section 93.05 – Severability – If any section, sub-section, clause, phrase or portion of the ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent portion of this ordinance, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 93.06 – All ordinances or parts of an ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 93.07 – This ordinance is declared necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Charter Township of Superior and is hereby given immediate effect upon the date of publication in the newspaper of record in the manner subscribed by law.
